Article Submission Guidelines:

The article should be 3–5 pages long in MS Word format (*.doc or *.docx), using Times New Roman font, size 12 pt, single spacing, and 2.5 cm margins on all sides. Page orientation must be portrait.

Author's full name, affiliation, city, country, and email should be in font size 11. The article title must be in uppercase, font size 12, and centered. The abstract should be italicized, size 11, justified. Keywords (7–10) must also be italicized, size 11.

The main text (font size 12) should include: introduction, relevance, objectives, results with discussion, and conclusion.

Figures should be in JPEG format, numbered (e.g., Fig. 1), and referenced in the text. Tables must be numbered (e.g., Table 1), titled in bold, size 11, centered, and referred to in the text. Content inside tables should be in size 11.

Formulas must be created and numbered using Microsoft Equation editor.

References should be listed alphabetically, with in-text citations in square brackets (e.g., [Gafurov et al., 2019]).
